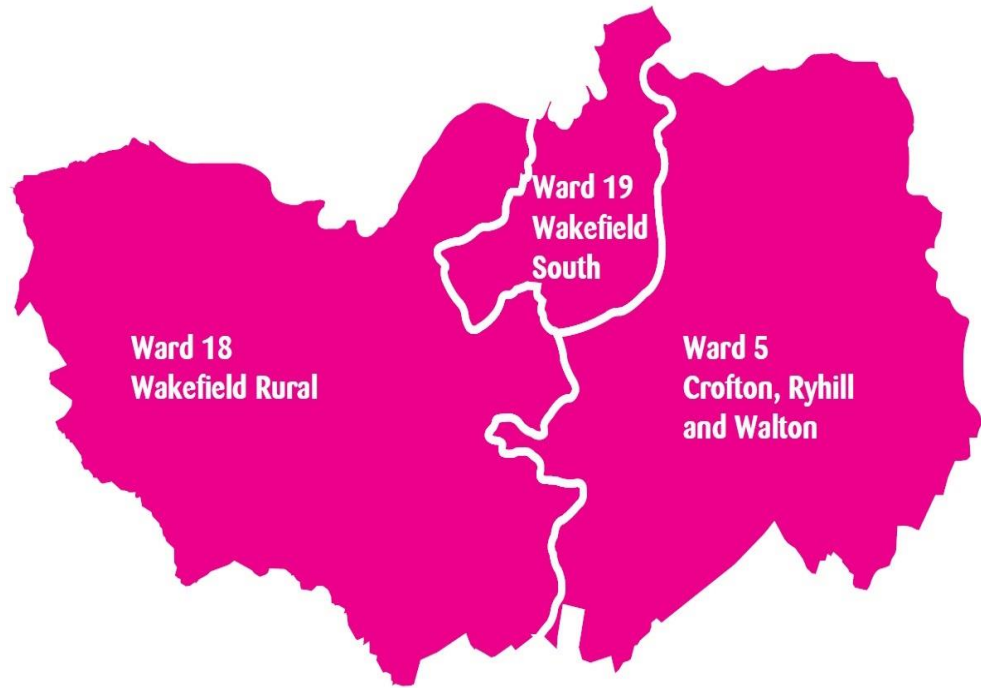

Over the summer holidays Havercroft and Ryhill Community Learning Centre ran Kids Kitchen with the help from the Area Working Team. Kid's kitchen took place every Tuesday feeding families from the local area, with fun activities to take part in as well.

In total we provided meals for 114 people!

SHARED LIVES

In Shared Lives, an adult who needs long term support is matched with a carefully approved Shared Lives Carer. Together they share family and community life. Some people using Shared Lives live with their Shared Lives Carer, sometimes for many years. Others may only stay for day support or overnight breaks. This gives family carers short breaks and time off to rest.

The service is used by adults of all ages with a wide range of support needs, disabilities and illness. Shared Lives Carers are given full training and on-going support.
